- The camp is fully funded by private donations and the campers stay free of charge.
- Camp Amigo is held every year at Billy Jo Rish State Park on Cape San Blas, just west of Apalachicola, Florida.
- Camp Amigo has a capacity of 56 children. They are provided free transport from the Gainesville, Jacksonville, and Tallahassee areas free of charge courtesy of local firefighters.
- While attending camp, children get to play on the beach, go to a water park, and participate in activities with firefighter counselors.
- The first Texas Hold Em Tournament for Camp Amigo in 2005 raised \$4000.
